We are seeking foreign university students who can share their enjoyment of outdoor activities with a group of Japanese junior high school students for three days in the beautiful natural surroundings of Nasu, Tochigi Prefecture.



★ PROJECT ★

Kita City Board of Education organizes a summer camp for junior high school students (7th and 8th graders) in Kita City to help them get used to the English language and improve their listening and language speaking abilities through interacting with foreign students during outdoor activities and cultural activities.

★ DATE ★

July 21(Wed.) to August 8(Sun.)

One round lasts three days and two nights(see application form for details).

※Each round includes a mandatory pre-meeting.

★ **Foreign Students' Main Roles** ★

- 1) Participants go to Nasu in Tochigi Prefecture by bus and enjoy hiking, cultural activities, and camp fire. (We have instructors to lead these activities.)
- 2) Participants should speak to Japanese students in English.
- 3) Before university students can take part in the camp, he/she is required to get permission from the Japanese government by completing the "Engage in Activity Other Than That Permitted Under the Status of Residence Previously Granted" form and have it approved.

★ **Number of Foreign Students Needed** ★ 200 students.

- ★ **Eligibility** ★
- 1) People who can enjoy being with junior high school students.
 - 2) Proficient in English (regardless of nationality).

- ★ **Expenses** ★ Kita City Board of Education will pay all expenses for accommodation, food, insurance and transportation (round trip from meeting place to Nasu).

- ★ **Remuneration** ★ 21,000 yen per round (before tax).
*Each round includes a mandatory pre-meeting and summer camp duties.

★ **Application** ★

Complete the application form and either fax/e-mail the form to the ESC Foreign Students Office, or submit the application form to the Foreign Students Division in your university.

ESC executive staff will interview all applicants and decide the round(s) for successful applicants to participate in. The ESC Foreign Students Office will inform applicants of the date and place of interview by phone, fax or e-mail.
